**The following are the amendments to the paragraphs of the Agreed Statement of Facts contained in Annex A to the SPECIAL AGREEMENT SUBMITTED TO THE INTERNATIONAL COURT OF JUSTICE BY THE REPUBLIC OF SYLDAVIA AND THE KINGDOM OF BORDURIA ON THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THEM CONCERNING THE ARMED INTERVENTION AND WAR DEBTS OF SYLDAVIA:**

8. On 24<sup>th</sup> June 2007, while the Constitutionalsists in Syldavia were celebrating their annual festival of “Sahroz” a series of explosions took place at three sites of religious and cultural importance to the Constitutionalsists resulting in the death of 401 Constitutionalsists. The leadership of KaHa, claiming full responsibility of the attacks, issued a statement avowing to “cleanse the holy land of Syldavia of all Traitor blood”.
  
36. The Republic of Syldavia opposes the claim contained in paragraph 37 and requests that the Court:
  - a. declare that the intervention carried out by the Chekisti forces since 23 November 2007, was, and continues to be, a violation of international law at all times, which is attributable to Borduria, and order for the removal of the said forces from Syldavia;
  - b. declare that the elimination, arrest and detention, acts of torture committed against Syldavian nationals by the Chekisti forces, as well as the removal of certain Syldavian nationals from the territory of Syldavia for trial in Borduria, is a violation of international law, for which Borduria is reponsible; and
  - c. declare that the debt owed to Borduria by and under the regime of General Alcazar does not bind the Republic of Syldavia, and for which the present government is not responsible.
  
37. The Kingdom of Borduria opposes the claim contained in paragraph 36 and requests that the Court:
  - a. declare that the intervention carried out by the Chekisti forces was legal at all times, or in the alternative, the said violation is not attributable to Borduria;

- b. declare that the elimination, arrest and detention, acts of torture committed against Syldavian nationals by the Chekisti forces, as well as the removal of certain Syldavian nationals from the territory of Syldavia for trial in Borduria, is not in violation of international law, nor is Borduria responsible for the same; and
- c. declare that the debt owed to Borduria by and under the regime of General Alcazar binds the Republic of Syldavia, for which the present government is responsible.

38. The Kingdom of Borduria and the Republic of Syldavia are members of the United Nations and have signed and ratified the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights.
