NAINA AHLUWALIA

Naina graduated from our University in 2008 and joined Wadia Ghandy & Co., where she worked on a variety of complex transactions and advised multiple Fortune 500 companies, leading private commercial banks, private equity firms and investment funds.

She completed her LL.M. from Georgetown University Law Centre in 2014. She is currently working as a Consultant for the World Bank for an assignment in the Health, Nutrition & Population Global Practice. Her work involves research and writing on health and pharmaceutical regulation in the East African Community.



SRIDAR P. KANNAN



After graduating in 2009, Sridar joined Tata Capital, where he worked on Corporate and Infrastructure Finance. Thereafter, he pursued an LL.M. in International Business and Economic Laws from Georgetown University.

Since 2011, he has been working as a Consultant with the World Bank in Washington D.C. His work mainly relates to mining industry policy.
