Mr. Sah graduated from our University in 2007 and is a part of the Alumni Visiting Faculty. After his stint with Majmudar & Co., where he worked with the M&A and Tax team, he joined Khaitan & Co. (Mumbai), where he is currently an Associate Partner with the



Corporate Team. He has considerable experience in advising on issues concerning outbound and inbound foreign investment, and is also a part of the Pharmaceuticals and Healthcare Practice Group at Khaitan & Co. AsiaLaw 2013 and 2014 noted him as a “Leading Lawyer” in India. Chambers Asia Pacific 2012 labelled him as an associate “to watch” and noted that sources singled him out for being “solution-oriented and pragmatic”.

He is also a mooting enthusiast. During his time at the University, he was a part of the Moot Court Committee. He is also the first NLUJ student to win the Best Speaker Award at the North India Rounds of Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Competition (2003-04).
