He has extensive experience in litigation, advisory and structuring specifically in the areas of Indirect Taxes, Foreign Contribution Regulation, Foreign Exchange Management, IPR, Consumer Protection, Money Laundering and Civil Litigation. Sameer has successfully argued and concluded tax and civil matters involving stakes of over INR 150 billion at Revenue Authority, CESTAT and High Courts and the Supreme Court. He extensively advises clients from Telecom, Retail, Oil and Gas, Power, Defence and Automotive sectors. Sameer is also a guest faculty at the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.
