In addition to the above positions, the number of positions for contractual engagement shall be decided by the Selection Committee.

Three posts out of the above posts are reserved for P.W.D. in terms of posts identified for each disability as per the notification issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment. The posts will be filled in the same order of specified categories (a) - (e) of the notification.

Qualifications, eligibility, experience, reservations and pay-level will be applicable as per UGC regulations.

Preferred specialization areas for faculty of law are as follows:

Constitutional Law, Administrative Law, Alternate Dispute Resolution, Jurisprudence, Criminal Law, Corporate Laws, Intellectual Property Rights, International Law, Labour & Industrial Laws, CPC, Evidence Law, International Trade Law.

Duly filled in application from along with the relevant supporting documents and non-refundable fee of Rs.1000/- should be submitted ONLINE on or before 17.04.2025. The application fee should be payable through the online link (nlujodhpur.ac.in/fee.php). SC, ST & PWD candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview or final selection.
2. The University reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed; or by any other condition that it may deem fit, including conduct of test for shortlisting of candidates.
3. Call letters for test/interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates through emails and no correspondence will be made with applicants who are not short-listed.
4. Preference will be given to candidates having experience of working at NLUs.
5. The candidates should clearly indicate their specialization as the University will keep the specializations in view while shortlisting the applicants as per its requirement.
6. The number of vacancies indicated in the Recruitment Notification are tentative. The University reserves the right to increase /decrease the number of posts, at the time of selection and make appointments accordingly, if more vacancies arise in between the advertisement and Selection Committee meetings. The University reserves the right not to fill any post/s if no suitable candidates are available.
7. The validity of panel of selected/waitlisted candidates will be as per the rules of Government of India.
8. Candidates applying for the reserved posts should clearly state the category to which they belong. They must also enclose attested photocopies of valid Caste Certificate / Medical Certificate (for PwD applicants) from the concerned competent authorities as per Govt. orders. The form of caste certificate to be produced by Other Backward Class (OBC) candidates must be in the format as prescribed by the Government of India, clearly specifying that they do not belong to "Creamy Layer" of the OBCs. Further, the caste to which the candidate belongs should be the one included in the Central list of OBC issued by the Government of India. A declaration shall also be submitted by the candidate that he/she does not belong to the Creamy Layer of OBC. Without valid certificate, the applications will not be considered against the reserved posts. In the absence of valid Caste Certificate, the applicant will be considered under Unreserved category.
9. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate will disqualify such a candidate.
10. The Selection Committee may decide its own method of evaluating the performance of the candidates in interview. The University may utilize written/skill test or seminar/colloquium or presentation as a method of selection.
11. The University may offer lower post to the candidate who may have applied for a higher post in case suitable candidates are not available for the advertised post.
12. It would be open to the University to consider the name of the suitable persons who may not have applied, but recommended by the experts in the respective fields.
13. The in-service candidates should apply through proper channel.
14. Separate application should be submitted for each post.
15. Qualifications, experience, etc. will be reckoned as on the last date for receipt of filled-in applications. Clear photocopies of all important certificates must be attached with the application.
16. Incomplete applications in any respect shall not be considered at all.
17. No interim queries regarding interview/ selection will be entertained.
18. In case of any disputes/suits or legal proceedings against the University, the Jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts in Jodhpur, which is the Headquarter of the University.
19. Any amendment or corrigendum will be published on the University Website.
20. Errors and omissions are subject to correction.

Eligibility Criteria/Requisite Qualification
(See the U.G.C. Regulations, 2018)

1. Associate Professor: Eligibility:

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
- iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of Seventy-five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2.

2. Assistant Professor : Eligibility (A or B) :

- A. i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions :-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

- B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) for universities, and Appendix II (Table 3B) for colleges, shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

3. Deputy Librarian

- i) A Master's Degree in Library Science, Information Science or Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree, with at least 55% marks or an equivalent grade in a point –scale, wherever the grading system is followed.
- ii) Eight years experience as an Assistant University Librarian/College Librarian.
- iii) Evidence of innovative library services including integration of ICT in library.
- iv) A Ph.D. Degree in library science/ Information science / Documentation Science / Archives and manuscript keeping/computerization of library.

4. Assistant Librarian

- i) A Master's Degree in Library Science, Information Science or Documentation Science or an equivalent professional degree, with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point –scale, wherever the grading system is followed)
- ii) A consistently good academic record, with knowledge of computerization of a library.
- iii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be:
Provided that the, candidates registered for the Ph.D. degree prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/ Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree, and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in the regular mode
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored /funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

Note: The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.
